Job Description

The Director of Programs & Partnerships fosters, mediates, and advances the engagement and connectedness between community institutions and the immigrant and limited-English speaking communities of the Teton region. The Director works with Voices JH staff, immigrant and limited-English speaking community members, and organizations to oversee, evaluate, and strengthen Voices's Community Engagement Programs: *Inform, Consult*, and *Involve*.

Core Duties

- Lead *Inform* services, including work with Voices' *Inform* membership partners and Voices JH team to distribute weekly content
- Lead *Consult* survey services, including the cultural competency review, managing community organizers working on the surveys, and ensuring Voices' delivers on set goals
- Lead *Involve* services for event planning, recruitment, and goals delivery
- Develop sales approach and impact reporting system for partnering organizations
- Serve as the primary supervisor for contracting, onboarding and work evaluation of the Community Mobilizers, Community Organizers, and Community Navigator
- Lead the evaluation of Voices JH's community engagement work and impact goals
- Participate as a representative of Voices JH in community processes, groups, networks, alliances and events
- Stay up to date on best practices for community engagement and programing
- Write programming updates for Voices JH social media, newsletter and quarterly reports
- Participate in trainings and personal and professional development opportunities
- Maintain program and team records, generate organizational documents, and report on impact goals

These core responsibilities are not intended to encompass all expectations of the Director of Programs & Partnerships, but to provide a general framework of the requirements of the position. Voices JH fosters a collaborative workspace and expects staff to work together to advance the work and mission of the organization.

- Ability to articulate Voices JH's mission and influence stakeholders to engage
- Strong organizational and planning skills with the ability to manage multiple projects at once
- Excellent interpersonal skills, community building skills, and conflict mediation skills
- Ability to work independently and within a team structure
- Ability to work in a fast-paced environment
- Big picture and strategic thinker
- Able to attend evening and weekend meetings and events
- Willingness to learn and commitment to personal and professional development
- Commitment to social justice and empowering others
- Bilingual in Spanish and English
